Language and the Arts

English This term we will be exploring tales told in Tents, a collection of stories and poems by Sally Pomme Clayton. We are looking closely at storytelling, reading aloud and performance poetry. Role play elements will be involved with all of the tales from Asian countries. We are continuing with our spelling programme where the children are enjoying the word puzzles and games to solve. Our nonfiction element will be a non-chronological report discovering the Asian countries.

History: We are looking at the beliefs in Ancient Middle East and Egypt. Exploring Baghdad, Early Islamic civilisations, Ancient Egyptian life, religion and culture.

Music The children will be exploring the song Lean on Me by Bill Whithers and Disco music.

Art and design - The children will look at Ancient Egyptian art and its significance.
