

Message from Chair of Governors -Academy Update

The first stage of academisation was to apply to the diocese for "Consent to Apply" to the Haygrove Multi Academy Trust (MAT). No progress could be made without this. The diocese had to be satisfied that what we, as a Church of England School, were doing was in the bests interests of the school. We have done this and have now been told that we have this consent.

The next stage is to discuss and agree the terms on which we will join the Haygrove MAT. This will hopefully be completed in

the next month and we will then be in a position to apply to the Department for Education. It is a slow process and overseen at every stage by the diocese and their legal team. We expect to convert to academy status at some point in the next academic year.

Governing Board update

The board of governors has felt it necessary to widen our skill base and have co-opted Debbie Mc Kenna to serve as a governor. Debbie lives in the village and is a parent of a child at the school. We welcome Debbie on board.
