Multi Academy Trust Update from the co- chairs of governors

We write to update on the Multi Academy Trust progress, as we are now reaching the final stages, with all paperwork falling into place. We continue to be excited by the new opportunities working together will create. This offers us many opportunities to extend and enrich the learning for our children and families, along with securing the future of our school, whilst retaining its unique and special identity and ethos. We are also in the unique position of forming and shaping the new Trust through our collaboration with Haygrove, building further on our existing close relationship with the school. Stogursey, Haygrove and Spaxton are working closely, aligning systems such as IT to ensure efficiency and best practice. The schools at Crowcombe and Stogumber have also expressed a strong interest in joining us, but are not yet ready to join us in time for the academy conversion date of August 1st. We look forward to welcoming them into the Trust at a later stage. We can also confirm that the new official name for the Trust is the Quantock Education Trust, which reflects the vision and ethos of the Trust, to establish close and inclusive links with the local community, serving the needs of its children and young people. <u>Attendance</u>

The number of holidays taken during the school term have increased dramatically, resulting in over 80 days of schooling being lost. This has a huge effect on the children's education and we will be looking at ways of reducing this figure next year.

PTFA updates

Alongside the pond and pagoda work, which the PTFA contributed $\pounds1256$ on top of the Calor gas grant of $\pounds5000$, the PTFA have raised money to support our IT infrastructure ($\pounds2350$), Trikes ($\pounds200$), SEND reading kit ($\pounds60$) and eggs for our Easter egg hunt ($\pounds20$). The PTFA have also contributed money to help reduce the cost of transport for school trips.

Roblox continues to be one of the most popular games amongst our children.
