Water bottles and hats

It is that time of year where the weather is either gloriously hot or miserable and wet! We do ask that all children have a hat and a water bottle in school to keep hydrated and to reduce the risk of heat stroke. We encourage the children to drink regularly and they can access water at any point of the day. We encourage water rather than squash or juice as it is not sticky when spilt and doesn't have a sugar content which can feed bacteria. Younger children are particularly at risk to overheating as they are not fully able to regulate their own body temperatures and can become hot and bothered easily.


Family First service
