Message from The Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers

I trust that you are all well and managing to cope still with all of the challenges facing us in our daily lives at the moment. I am encouraged by the lifting of some of the restrictions, but at the same time acutely aware of the ongoing dangers of lifting them too early, so we are maintaining our vigilance as we endeavour to restore some normality around our school provision.

Our first whole week of extended provision has gone well and we have managed to accommodate a few more children of key workers in to each of our classes. We are now creating a plan for the rest of this term and have decided that our priority must be full time provision for the children of key workers and those in vulnerable groups. The government has now accepted that it is unlikely that primary schools will be able to open to all year groups, given the requirements for 'social distancing'. We are however, keen to see all of our children before the summer break and are planning to organise a series of 'picnic on the field' events for the children in year groups which do not fall in to the eligible categories. These will of course be dependent on the weather conditions so that the children can spend time together with their teachers, taking part in some fun activities whilst maintaining 'social distancing'. I shall keep you informed of the dates for these events, but emphasise that they could be subject to some changes at short notice.

In the meantime, we shall continue to deliver information and resources for home learning, making as many links as possible with the learning programmes being delivered in school. I hope also that engagement with our new Class Dojo app will help to keep us all in touch with each other regarding your child's achievements both in and out of school.

Flapjacks





This is a picture of Anna Cook in Reception – Anna has been doing lots of baking at home with Mum, and has been telling the class how to make flapjacks and what ingredients you need! Here is a simple flapjack recipe to try at home:

Ingredients:

250g jumbo porridge oats
125g butter
125g light brown sugar
2-3 tbsp golden syrup
(depending on how gooey you want it)



- Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6.
- Put 250g jumbo porridge oats, 125g butter, 125g light brown sugar and 2-3 tbsp golden syrup in a food processor and pulse until mixed, but be careful not to overmix otherwise oats may lose their texture.
- Lightly grease a 20x20cm baking tin with butter and spoon in the mixture. Press into the corners with the back of a spoon so the mixture is flat and score into 12 squares.
- Bake for around 15 minutes until golden brown.
