Every child has their own pair of wellingtons kept in school and these are an essential part of their everyday school kit!

From September 2020, we are introducing a weekly Forest School for all children on a 3-week rotation. This initiative will ensure a whole day spent exploring outside the classroom for every child several times a year across all the seasons.

Pupils have two Physical Education (PE) classes per week and in the summer term swimming is timetabled for every year group. We believe that regular exercise, whether through play or the curriculum helps with both mental and physical health and resilience.

We are a Church of England affiliated school and have close links with the Church of St Margaret in Spaxton villiage. Pupils visit for special ceremonies and we also provide daily collective worship in school, sometimes hosted by the local church leaders.
